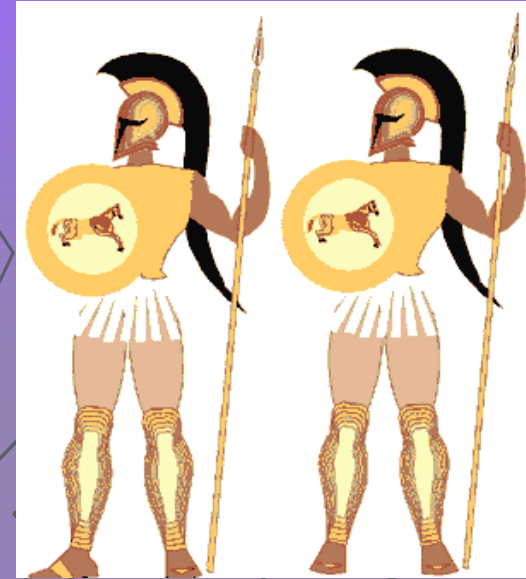

Planning Ahead For Change

- ▶ If a successful student in Area Studies wants a level change to a more challenging curriculum they may take **AP Modern European History**
- ▶ If an Area Studies student wants to enroll in a history class as a Sophomore they may take **World Civilizations 2 CP** or **World Civilizations 1 CP** (Taking World Civ I as a sophomore, however, is a very rare occurrence.)

Planning Ahead For Change

1. A student can take two Area Studies classes as a freshman and qualify to be recommended for AP Modern European History as a Sophomore.
2. The student must have earned "A's" in their Area Studies classes to be recommended for AP Modern European History and Contemporary Issues.

Planning Ahead For Change

3. A student can enroll in either World Civilizations 1 or World Civilizations 2 as a Sophomore with no prerequisite.
4. A student must have taken World Civilizations 1 (CP or Honors) to enroll in AP World History. Therefore, a student taking an Area Study cannot enroll in the AP World History Class.

Social Studies at Lake Forest High School provide each student with the opportunity to explore interests, examine topics, participate in Advanced Placement programs as well as becoming involved in a learning process that emphasizes thinking, discussing, sharing and creating.
