



Boys' Soccer Team Rules 2008-2009

Attendance – Mandatory for all Practices and Games

- A. Exceptions
 - 1. Illness-Please notify coach.
 - 2. Prearranged- **Must** be arranged, in writing, with coach 1day in advance.
 - 3. Excessive absences- Each case will be handled individually, but will result in loss of playing time.
- B. Penalty for unexcused absence
 - 1. First offense-One game suspension.
 - 2. Second office-Considered a violation of Athletic Code 20 %.
- C. Once the athlete has accumulated **ten (10)** total absences during the entire season, the athlete may be removed from the roster.
- D. Every player at each level will have to participate in **ten 10** sessions prior to playing in their first game.
- E. Transportation
 - 1. Players are required to take the bus to and from all games. It is part of the team commitment and camaraderie.
 - 2. Special occasion exceptions must be arranged in writing with coach 1 day in advance.

Suspension Rules

- A. Violation of team rule
 - 1. Player is still part of team and expected to be at all team functions.
 - 2. Player will help on sidelines at games and practice.
 - 3. Unexcused absence during suspension will result in athletic code violation.
- B. Violation of Athletic Code
 - 1. Player is still part of team and expected to be at all team functions.
 - 2. Player will help on sidelines at games and practice.
 - 3. Unexcused absence will be considered **another** athletic code violation.

Eligibility

- A. IHSA rules require players to be passing four core classes.
- B. Academic ineligibility from previous week results in one week game suspension.
- C. Ineligible players are required to attend mandatory Study Table sessions after school.

Curfew

- A. Recommendations
 - 1. Weekdays
 - a. Home = 8:00 pm
 - b. In bed = 9:00 pm
 - c. Asleep = 10:00 pm
 - 2. Friday (prior to morning games or practices)
 - a. Home = 9:00 pm
 - b. In bed = 10:00 pm
 - c. Asleep = 11:00 pm
- B. Curfew Infractions
 - 1. Each case will be handled individually, but will result in loss of playing time.
 - 2. Continual and intentional violations will result in team suspension and violation of athletic code.
