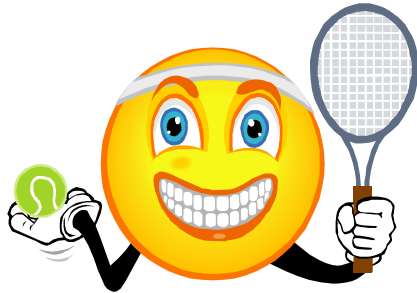

Email is the best way to reach me during the school day. If your player is going to be late to a match or practice, and I have not been emailed earlier in the day, please use my cell phone to call me ASAP so I can make the necessary adjustments.

Practice and Matches

Practice is Monday-Friday starting as soon as the Scout Bus drops players off (around 3:45) – 5:45/6:00PM. Fridays are generally conditioning days and players are released at around 5:15/5:30. There is a shuttle bus that runs from East to West Campus at the end of the day. Players that do not have their own rides will need to utilize the shuttle in order to make it to West Campus for practice and home matches. If the weather is questionable, always check the coach's door for up-to-date information in terms of cancellations and location changes. **IF A PLAYER WILL NOT MAKE IT TO A PRACTICE, YOU MUST NOTIFY THE COACH ASAP!**

Matches played at home begin as soon as the visiting team arrives. The schedule may say 4:30PM but I expect you to arrive just as you would for practice. For away matches, the transportation will be the Scout Bus driven by your coach. Only 14 players can fit on the bus (7 when we take the van), the remaining players will have a shortened practice at West Campus under the supervision of the Varsity coaches (Saturdays will not be practice days). For tournaments played on Saturdays, the time and meeting location will be determined closer to the date. **IF A PLAYER WILL NOT MAKE IT TO A MATCH, YOU MUST NOTIFY THE COACH ASAP!**

****Please report any absence from practice/match in a timely manner (before practice/match). Failure to do so may result in missing the next match.****

Parents – during a match you are not allowed to talk to your player! The only time you may speak to your player is if it is before a match or after a match. Failure to comply will result in point penalties and a negative reputation!

Conduct

It is my expectation and that of Lake Forest High School that players demonstrate sportsmanlike conduct both on AND off the court. You are expected to be respectful and courteous to your teammates as well as your opponents and coaches. Foul language and demonstrations of aggression and anger will not be tolerated. Also, practice and matches are time for TEAM participation. Do not approach me about playing time and challenge matches during practice or matches, if you do so, your playing time will be affected because you are demonstrating that your primary focus is yourself and not the team. Please feel free to email me, talk to me at school, or wait until after a practice or a match.

Behaviors during practice such as intentionally defying instruction and constantly being told to get back on task will result in a reduction of playing time.

Eligibility

School always comes first; however, it is the responsibility of the player to find the balance between commitments at school and with athletics. If you find yourself becoming overwhelmed and your grades are being affected, please speak to me and I will try to help you out. Skipping practices and matches is not the answer, as your teammates and coach rely on you. As with all sports at LFHS, all players must be passing 2.0 credit hours weekly.
