- Landscape Architect, Stephen Christy was introduced. Mr. Christy presented an overview of the East Campus landscape project and reported that Phase I has been completed. The Committee discussed implementation of future phases.
- Dr. Griffith reported that District 115 and the City of Lake Forest are initiating a preliminary engineering study to determine the feasibility of adding dedicated turn lanes on Highway 43 at Westleigh Road. The District and the City will split the cost of the study.
- Allen reported that T-Mobile will submit a proposal to lease space for equipment on the roof at East Campus. Cellular One is currently leasing space. Approval of the lease will be on the Board Agenda this month.
- Dr. Griffith reported that the WAN project was approved at the City Council meeting on December 1<sup>st</sup>. He presented an overview of the plan that the city approved and how it will affect each school district.
- Allen presented an update of SEDOL negotiations. He will meet with the Architect and SEDOL representatives next week. Allen will keep the Committee updated.
- Dr. Griffith reported that students are staying longer to “hang-out” at school and as a result the library is remaining open later. He discussed the possibility of opening a snack shop for the students staying later in the evening. He explained that some schools are adding coffee shops to draw in students.
- Dr. Griffith reported that Carol White will bring the long range facility plan to the next meeting. The was adjourned at 10:05.
