

**Minutes of a Special Meeting
Of the Operations Committee
Lake Forest Community High School District 115**

May 3, 2011

- Mr. Block greeted LFHS Booster Club members Bill Bund and Brian Vandenberg. Dr. Griffith presented a brief update of the LFHS Booster Community Partnership Program. The group discussed the success of the pilot program as well as other potential revenue generating opportunities. The Committee endorsed moving forward with the placement of art panels at the Varsity Field.
- Mr. Bund and Mr. Vandenberg proposed a parent sponsored campaign (Diamond Anniversary Campaign). The campaign would privately fund construction of a multi-purpose sports complex at East Campus. This complex would benefit both students (Wellness classes) and athletes. The group discussed the project and the timeline. The proposal will be presented to the Board of Education and the community at the June 14th Board meeting. The committee thanked the Booster Club representatives for their dedication to our students.
- Allen reported on the status of the Transportation Bid. The transportation bid will most likely go to the Board of Education in June as the bid specs are complicated and it will take some time to compile the results. GCA (current custodial service) proposed a one-year contract renewal which provides substantial cost savings to the district.
