Curriculum and Instruction

Approx. 2 years/M.Ed.
32 semester hours/M.Ed. or
30 semester hours/C.A.S.

Choose to work toward an endorsement in areas such as ESL, Math, Science, Health, Social Studies, or Library. Or select from a variety of courses to enhance your teaching skills.

Interdisciplinary Studies Curriculum and Instruction

Approx. 20 months/M.Ed.
32 semester hours/M.Ed.

Offered on campus one night a week or online. Develop your own classroom-based action research project; National Board Certification component is available.

Administration and Supervision

Approx. 18 months/M.Ed.
34 semester hours/M.Ed. or
30 semester hours/Ed.S.

Earn your degree through our traditional model, with classes once a week on campus or through our blended model, which meets three Saturdays per term supplemented by online instruction.

Technology in Education

20 months/M.Ed.
34 semester hours/M.Ed.

Expand and advance computer skills within your current curriculum. Certified teachers can earn a Type 10 Technology Specialist certificate on top of their teaching certificate. Offered online with one face-to-face residency or traditionally with classes once a week.

Reading Specialist

Approx. 2 years/M.Ed.
36 semester hours/M.Ed.
32 semester hours/C.A.S.

For teachers with initial certification who are interested in developing their teaching practice as well as qualifying as reading teachers or specialists. Can earn a Type 10 reading specialist certificate. Twenty of the required hours are offered in a 2 year sequence and practicum is done on campus at a reading center.

Mathematics Education

Approx. 2 years/M.Ed.
32 semester hours/M.Ed. or
30 semester hours/C.A.S.

Specifically designed for currently certified K-8 teachers. Offered only in a cohort model at off-site locations. The next cohorts are scheduled to be in the Barrington, IL area and the Glendale Heights, IL area.

Library Information Specialist Endorsement

Minimum 24 semester hours

Certified teachers earn an endorsement to become a school librarian. Coursework includes school librarianship, literature and reading, and technology in education. Coursework can be applied to the M.Ed. in Language and Literacy or Curriculum and Instruction.
