



East Campus Opens

Almost two years ago, Lake Forest High School came to the community asking for support of a building bond referendum to fund the renovation and expansion of its East Campus and improve portions of the West Campus facility and fields. After presenting a comprehensive plan, you, our community, overwhelming supported this initiative.

We thank you!

For a little more than 18 months we have focused on the construction and renovation project. We are pleased to announce the project is complete.

Academic Improvements

The **library** and **resource centers** have been relocated, updated and expanded for enhanced academic use. The cafeteria has been upgraded and enlarged to accommodate student enrollment, today and at full community build-out.

In the **music wing** addition, students are enjoying three large group rooms for daily practice and numerous smaller practice spaces. The rooms were designed with improved acoustics to enhance the experience for music students and sound-proofing to ensure a quiet academic environment for others.

Former music spaces were renovated to be used as additional classrooms to address increased enrollment and academic program improvements.

Project Data

- Added 113,500 square feet
- Repurposed 68,500 square feet
- Constructed 20 new classrooms and numerous student support spaces and project rooms
- Reconfigured or expanded 19 existing classrooms
- Added three new science labs
- Added four new computer labs

Improved Safety & Security

Two multi-floor **evacuation routes** were added to the south side of the school, other safety features include additional public safety access to the building, **sprinklers** in all academic areas, and ramping and elevators to meet Americans with Disability Act (ADA) standards. East Campus parking has been reconfigured to improve overall safety by limiting and controlling points of public access. Dedicated drop off and bus lanes also assist in efficient **traffic management**.

Fiscally Responsible & Environmentally Friendly

The new parking lot to the north of the school is not only functional but it is also environmentally friendly. The highly pervious brick **paving system** eliminates the need for costly storm water management alternatives.

The new roof of the music wing is planted with drought-tolerant plants which help reduce storm water runoff on school grounds. New **green roofs** will reduce cooling and heating expenses and extend the life of the roof.

West Campus

We thank those who attended the first Friday Night Game under the lights at Scout Varsity Field at West Campus. In addition to football, the new **turf field** will be used for soccer, lacrosse and is available for community use. Private donations provided funding to underwrite the cost of lights for the field.

Improvements were also made to the locker room, existing gyms, and new outdoor restroom facilities.

Inside the building, infrastructure was upgraded and zoned to improve energy efficiency. Portions of the existing building were renovated to house the LFHS and District 67 Shared Services **Administrative Offices** - freeing up space at LFHS East Campus and Deer Path Middle School for academic use.

Additionally, **Little Scouts Preschool** has relocated to West Campus. This new location has allowed the program to expand and open its doors to the public.
