Juniors students and their parents are invited to Student Services Parent Meetings and College Resource Center Presents "On the Road to College" on Thursday, January 28 at 7:00 PM in the Raymond Moore Auditorium at Lake Forest High School. Guest speakers include Greg Moyer, Associate Director of Admission, Dickinson College; Sally H. Lindsley, Senior Associate Director of Admission, The University of Michigan; Ray Brown, Dean of Admission, Texas Christian University; and Jacquie Berkshire, LFHS College Counselor. The goal of this program is to offer insights about the college search and selection process. Parents will be informed of "The Parent Perspective Survey," which is available on Naviance, an LFHS web based program. Juniors and parents are expected to meet with their assigned counselor before the end of the school year.

Second semester Driver Education students/parents are invited to "Driver Education Parent Night" on Thursday, January 28 from 7:00 pm – 9:00 pm in the David Miller Theater at Lake Forest High School. This is an informational meeting for the parents of second semester Driver Education students.

Effective January 1, 2010 no cell phones are to be used in a school zone. In addition to the new Illinois law that went into effect on January 1, 2010 prohibiting text messaging while driving, another law that took effect on January 1 is Senate Bill 72; "Provides that a

person, regardless of age, may not use a wireless telephone in a school speed zone ...”
