LFHS students may drop a semester course or request a level change without penalty by Monday, November 16, 2009. The Pass/Fail option deadline is also on Monday, November 16 and is available to ONLY seniors. The student must be enrolled in five classes including the one he/she is requesting for the Pass/Fail option but not including Wellness. If a student falls below five classes because of dropping a class, the Pass/Fail option is null and void. Students must submit the form signed by student, parent, teacher, counselor and the Student Services Director no later than November 16, 2009. Quarter and semester grades will be issued in the usual format. The letter "P" for Pass will appear on the transcript if the grade is "D-" or better at the end of the semester. A "P" has no impact on the GPA. The letter "F" will appear on the transcript and will have an impact on the GPA and no credit will be earned, if the class is failed. The actual letter grade will appear on the report card and can be recorded on the transcript by giving written notification to the Student Services Director within one week of receiving grades. Otherwise a "P" will be recorded on the transcript. For additional information, please see your counselor.
