Students will receive their cap & gown at graduation rehearsal. There will be a senior class party, also, on Thursday, June 3 from 5:30 pm – 8:00 pm at LFHS on the front lawn.

LFHS Class of 2010 graduation will be held on Saturday, June 5 at Lake Forest High School on the front lawn. Seniors should arrive at 1:20 p.m. Guest are encouraged to arrive at 2:00 p.m. There will be unlimited seating on the front lawn. In case of inclement weather, each graduate will receive a limited number of tickets for admission to the Field house, the alternate location for graduation. Additional seating for guests without tickets will be available in the Competition Gym where the ceremony will be televised via closed circuit TV. The graduation ceremony will take place from 2:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.
