June 5 will be Final Exams for Math and the last day of school for all students.

On June 5, Senior students will have their Senior Breakfast from 11:00 am - 12:30 pm. Graduation rehearsal will be following breakfast. There will be a Senior Lawn Party from 5:30 pm - 8:00 pm at Lake Forest High School on the front lawn.

Book Buy-back will be held at Lake Forest High School West Campus, 300 S. Waukegan Road, on the following dates and times: Thursday, June 5, from 12:00 pm - 3:00 pm and on Friday, June 6, from 9:00 am - 12:00 pm. There will be only one time to enter and complete the book buy-back process per student. Only hardcover textbooks in good condition that will be used in 2008-09 will be bought back. Softcover textbooks will not be accepted. All textbooks to be sold back must be completed at the same time. Textbooks being bought back must match the student schedule for courses taken during the 2007-2008 school year only.

The Graduation Ceremony for the class of 2008 will be held on June 7 at 2:30 pm on the Lake Forest High School Front Lawn. Seniors arrive at LFHS at 1:30 p.m. Guests arrive at 2:00 pm. There will be unlimited seating on the front lawn. In case of inclement weather, each graduate will receive a limited number of tickets for admission

to the Fieldhouse, the alternate location for Graduation. Additional seating for guests without tickets will be available in the Competition Gym where the ceremony will be televised via closed circuit TV.

The LFHS East Campus building will become a construction site on Tuesday, June 11 when work will continue on the student commons, new media center, resource centers, classrooms and departmental offices. This summer, sole access to the building will be via the McKinley Road entrance with parking available only in the north lot in front of the pool. The back parking lot will become a closed construction site and will be inaccessible to all traffic. Entrance to the academic wing will only be through the center main doors. The doors at the cafeteria foyer and Auditorium foyer will be locked. The Main Office (Room 106) and the Student Service Office (Room 104) both located right off of the Senior Star will be the only offices open. At the north end, the Athletic Office will be open. Summer School U.S. History will be held at Deer Path and Summer School Driver Education Classes will be held in the mobile classrooms north of the Fieldhouse. Summer Athletic Camps will be held at the Athletic end and at West Campus, depending on the camp.

Three Lake Forest High School students placed in the Regional CAD Competition at the College of Lake County. Marissa Moore took 3rd place in Advanced 3D Architecture. In the 3D Solids division Lake Forest dominated the competition as Christian Neumeister took 1st place and Tucker Moore finished 2nd. Both Christian and Tucker competed at the State CAD Competition at Illinois State University on April 12 where nearly 1200 participants competed in 8 different divisions. Congratulations to both students for representing Lake Forest High School and especially to Tucker Moore who took 3rd place in the "3D Solids division."
