

Chinese Exchange Students coming to LFHS in Fall 2011



On Monday, October 3, twelve high school students from Shanghai, China will be spending two weeks at LFHS as part of the Mandarin Chinese Exchange program which began two years ago. The visitors will be staying with host families whose high school son or daughter will be going to Shanghai for two weeks in the spring. Not only will the Chinese students be participating in high school classes and activities, they will tour Chicago, visit a

Chicago high school, museums, and the University of Chicago campus. A trip to a Wisconsin dairy farm, apple picking and a hayride is also on the agenda. The students will visit both Lake Forest and Lake Bluff elementary school districts along with historic tours of both communities.
